



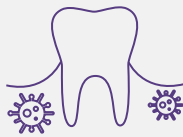

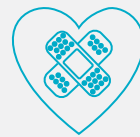

Better Protections.

Stringent Quality Assurance

Dentists who join our network must agree to abide by our processing policies and network contract. This includes a thorough credentialing process to join the network and ongoing re-credentialing processes to ensure dentists continue to meet certain requirements.

Zero Balance Billing

Network dentists cannot balance bill and are prohibited from unbundling or re-bundling claims – ensuring separate fees are not charged for work included in certain procedures. By prohibiting dentists from collecting any amounts over our allowed fees, we protect members from unexpected charges.

Unrivaed Service Warranties

Our policies and contracts require network dentists to warranty many of the procedures they perform. If a Delta Dental member needs to have an applicable service redone within a certain timeframe, neither the member nor the member's plan is responsible for the cost of the re-treatment – provided the procedure is performed by the same dentist who rendered the initial service.

Fillings	Within 24 months of initial restoration
Placement of a crown	Within 6 months of initial seating date
Root canal therapy or re-treatment	Within 24 months of initial treatment
Denture lining/basing	Within 6 months of initial treatment



Preventive Care Emails*

When it comes to staying healthy, a little preventive care can go a long way. To encourage your employees and members to visit the dentist regularly for preventive care, we send email reminders to employees and members who have not been to the dentist recently (provided we have their email address and they have not opted out). We also send follow-up emails to employees and members who have previously been treated for gum disease but have not visited the dentist for some time.

During a routine visit, a dentist can detect early signs of many diseases including heart disease and diabetes — and other oral health concerns that could become more painful and expensive if left untreated. Preventive dental care is crucial for both oral and overall health and also contributes to employee wellness.

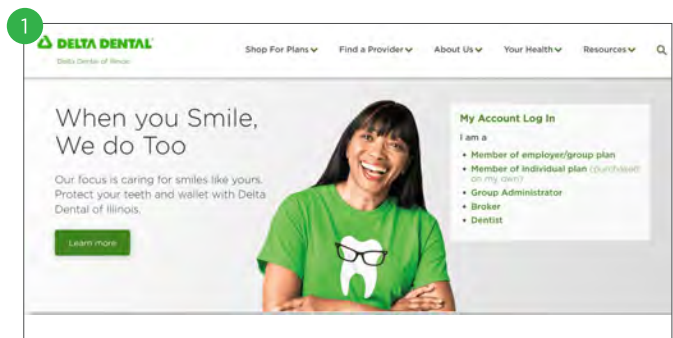

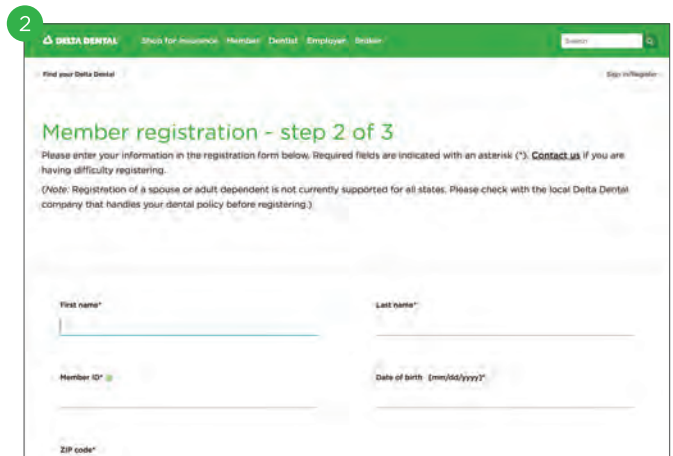


How to Register:

- 1 Go to deltadentalil.com, select "Member of employer/group plan" in the "My Account Log In" box located on the right side of the homepage. On the next page, click "Don't have an account? Create an account." Select "I am a member or adult dependent and have coverage with Delta Dental" on the next screen.




- 2 Enter the primary member's first and last name (the name must appear exactly as what your employer entered during enrollment; for example, "Bob" may be "Robert"). Please note there is a 10-character limit for first name and a 15-character limit for last name. For example, if your first name is Christopher, you are limited to Christophe for first name. You will also need to enter the primary member's assigned member ID (if your member ID is less than 9 digits, you need to enter zero's in front of the number; for example, 001234567) or Social Security number and date of birth (enter two-digit month, two-digit day and four-digit year with dividers; for example, 03/15/1984).

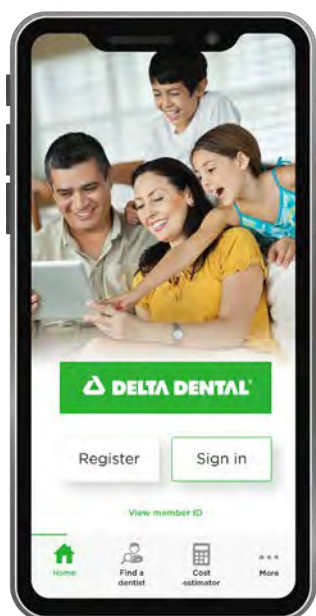

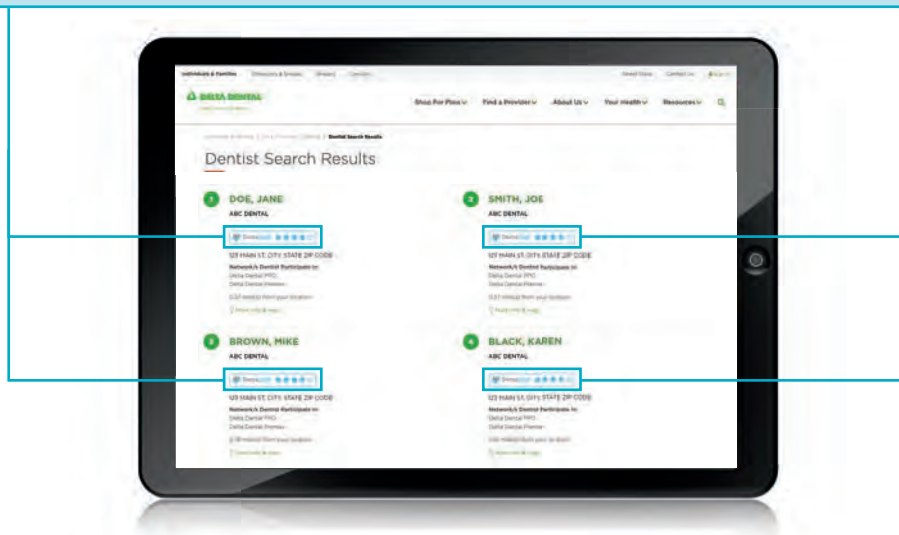
Finding the right dentist made easier with DentaQual® ratings

There has been a growing demand in the marketplace for an objective tool to assist members in evaluating dentist quality, and for employer groups, higher quality of care translates to more value for your buying dollar. A new feature of Delta Dental of Illinois' dentist directory, the DentaQual dentist quality rating system, is based on comprehensive data to empower members to navigate dentist options with ease. Powered by P&R Dental Strategies, the DentaQual rating system offers an independent, third-party scoring system based on a database of anonymized and aggregated claims that are continuously updated.

How DentaQual ratings work

When members search Delta Dental of Illinois' dentist directory, dentists with enough sufficient data will be assigned a score between one to five stars.* DentaQual ratings are based on claims data submissions from P&R Dental Strategies' multi-payer claims database, DentaBase®, rather than subjective patient reviews or testimonials. DentaQual compares each provider's score to the average score of their peers in the same specialty and geography to generate an overall quality rating that is updated monthly. In the directory, a score button will appear beneath the provider's name with a text description of the provider's score.

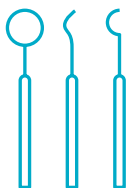

What are DentaQual scores are based on?



Treatment outcomes

Measures a dentist's treatment success rate including the likelihood of repeat procedures and post-treatment problems.



Commitment to best practices

Evaluates how well a dentist follows established dental standards and treatment methods, including sequence of prescribed care.



Cost-effectiveness

Compares the types and number of prescribed treatments as well as the average cost per patient for submitted dental fees and treatments.



Patient retention

Evaluates the degree of patient retention and loyalty as well as active sanctions, if any.



Treatment recommendations

Compares how a dentist recommends treatments in relation to other dentists in their ZIP Code and specialty.

What causes hearing loss?

Hearing loss is caused by temporary obstructions in the outer or middle ear or permanent damage to the tiny hairs in the inner ear. Common causes of damage include exposure to noise, aging, other health conditions, and certain medications.

When should I get my hearing checked?

Hearing loss can come on so gradually that you may not even notice it's happening. In general, you should have your hearing screened every three to five years, and tested annually if you are over the age of 50 or experiencing any of the following:

- **Consistent exposure** to loud noises.
- **Difficulty understanding** in noisy environments or in groups.
- **Hearing mumbling** or feeling as though people are not speaking clearly.
- **Ringings** in your ears.
